How Effective Are Inpatient Addiction Recovery Centers?

Patients also relapse because they do not have proper aftercare plans put in place. Before an individual leaves the recovery center, it is important for them to meet with a counselor to develop the abilities and coping skills necessary to deal with negative problems. These skills help an individual learn how to cope with negative feelings and avoid reaching for drugs as a means of coping with problems and managing their emotions and stress levels.

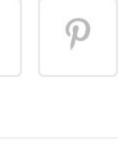
What to Look For in an Inpatient Addiction Recovery Center
