- Setting realistic goals and acknowledging when we achieve them.

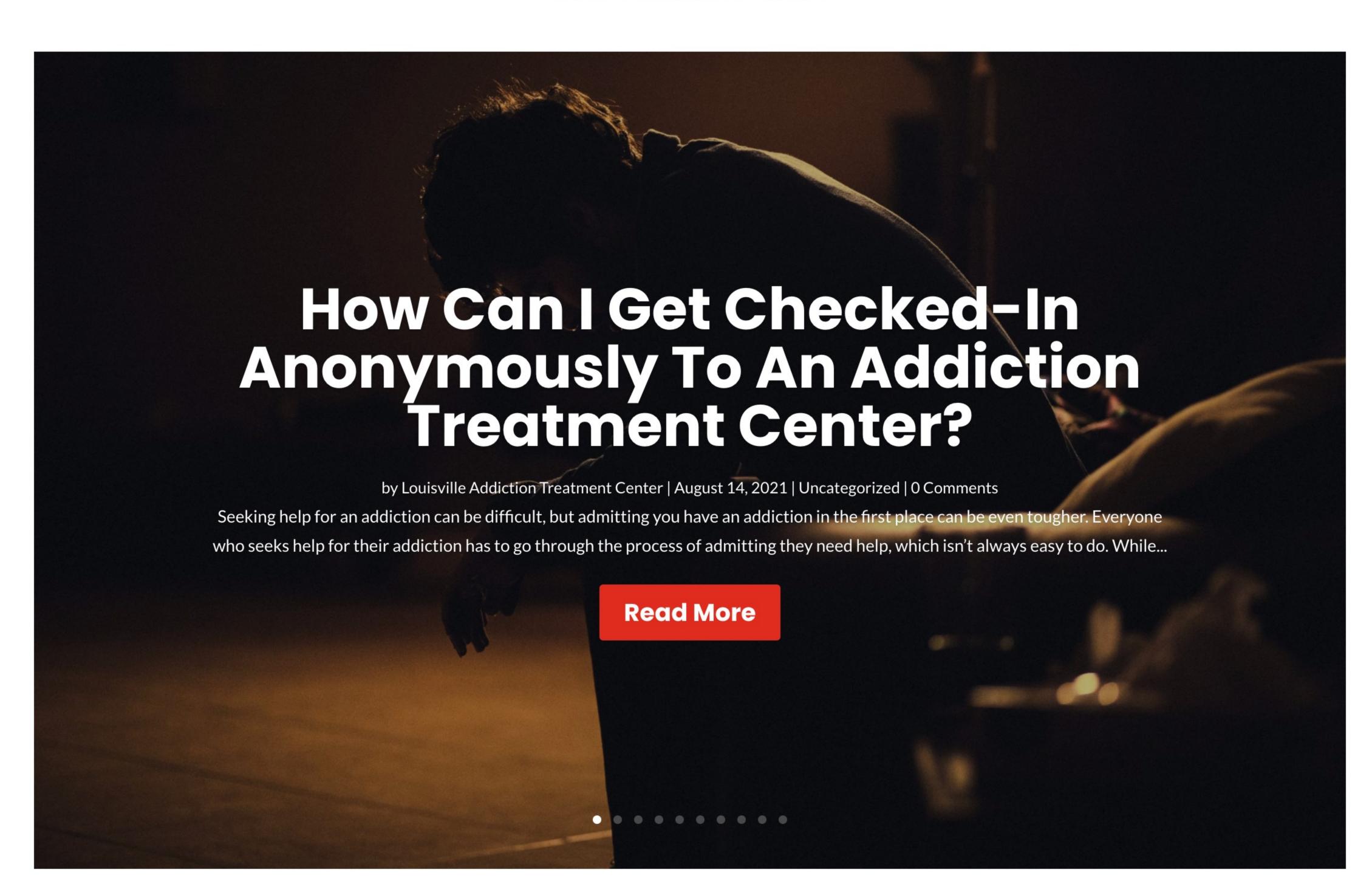
Lastly, try to focus on your progress instead of comparing yourself to others. Remember that everyone's journey is unique, and progress looks different for everyone.
